**Re: Statement of intent regarding Field Hockey Canada dues increase**

Dear Members,

Please accept this statement of intent regarding an increase to the Field Hockey Canada dues. As discussed at the 2016 General Meeting, it is the intention of Field Hockey Canada to propose at our 2017 General Meeting an increase to individual participant dues that will take effect September 1, 2017 and under the following details:

- To increase the Field Hockey Canada individual participant dues in the following categories as follows;
  - \$6.00 increase for all Senior athletes;
  - \$6.00 increase for all Junior athletes (Under 13 to Under 18);
  - \$3.00 increase for all other categories (coach, official, Under 12, etc).

It is our intention at the 2017 Field Hockey Canada General Meeting to propose that the income from the increase in dues be invested, annually moving forward, into the domestic development of the game across Canada as follows:

- **Coach and Officials Education:** establish a domestic program lead to work with member Provinces in delivery of courses, course curriculum updates, CAC liaison and related administration, support for Provinces phasing in mandatory education programs, and working with Provinces in the identification and development of Canadian coaches and officials recognized as having potential to represent Canada at international events.



- **Officials Education and Development:** provide support to enhance international development opportunities for Canadian officials, including education opportunities, and enhance support for officials appointed for international tours, PAHF and FIH events.

This statement of intent is to allow for our Members to best plan for these proposed increases, assuming they are implemented at the Field Hockey Canada 2017 General Meeting. I would be pleased to take any questions in advance of our our General Meeting on July 23 in Surrey.
