Nature of the Agreement:

These are part-time and limited contractual agreements for provision of coaching services. The JWNT Program is under the supervision of Field Hockey Canada's High Performance Leadership Team consisting of High Performance Director, Operations Manager and NextGen Director.

Term:

This short term contract will be from October 2022 – April 2023 and will cover upcoming tours and preparation for Junior Pan American Games including:

- Winter tour to Mexico (December 28 – Jan 7th)
- Winter Preparation Camp (TBD – Feb/Mar)
- Junior Pan American Games April 10-17th in Barbados.

Continuation of this contract subject to a positive performance review after the conclusion of the above elements.

Location:

Variable and to be determined based on the location of training and competition.

Scope:

The manager will be engaged in the processes for team preparation and execution of training periods, and preparation and execution of competition periods including managing budget, travel, accommodation, nutrition, scheduling and liaising with local organizing contacts and on the ground team and athlete management.

- Experience with responsibilities and logistics of providing of video support to teams.
- Experience with, or commitment to learn, Sport Code or NAC Sport video analysis and coding software.
- Must be self-directed, and able to source international video, analyse and provide reports to the head coach on international opponents,
- Must provide timely coding and feedback on JWNT competition and training environment film.
- Experience delivering high performance coaching and instruction to junior aged athletes, and ability to use analysis to support planning and delivery of instruction.
- Must be committed to working within the coaching staff to support JWNT success and performance on field.
- Coaches may be asked to support some managerial tasks.

Both Coach and Manager will be expected to participate in program debrief processes and report on the successes and opportunities after each event.
