Nature of the Agreement:

These are part-time and limited contractual agreements for the provision of coaching services. The U16 & U18 Programs are under the supervision of Field Hockey Canada's High-Performance Leadership Team consisting of the High-Performance Director, Operations Manager, NextGen Director and Pathway Manager.

Terms:

U16 Women's and Men's National Team:

This short-term contract will be from January 2023 – August 2023 and will cover the following:

- Pre-Tour Preparation; including athlete ID, selection, performance planning, and development of technical/tactical principles in line with FHC style of play.
- Responsible for coordinating U16 athlete evaluations and distribution of mid-point athlete feedback reports end of March 2023
- Den Bosh Tournament (Netherlands) (May 19 – May 30th)
- Event Debrief Report to FHC
- Athlete Evaluation using FHC gap analysis and Formal Athlete Feedback Reports
- Talent ID and ongoing monitoring of U16 Athletes through NextGen DTE training.
- With the support of DTE coaches, coordinate the distribution of athlete feedback reports to all U18 athletes by Aug 2023.



U18 Women's National Team:

This short-term contract will be from January 2023 – August 2023 and will cover the following:

- Pre-Tour Preparation; including athlete ID, selection, performance planning, and development of technical/tactical principles in line with FHC style of play.
- Responsible for coordinating U18 athlete evaluations and distribution of mid-point athlete feedback reports end of March 2023
- France Tour (Apr 15 – Apr 22nd)
- International matches (Toronto) (TBT – Jul/Aug)
- Event Debrief Report to FHC
- Athlete Evaluation using FHC gap analysis and Formal Athlete Feedback Reports
- Talent ID and ongoing monitoring of U18 Athletes through NextGen DTE training and final evaluation and
- With the support of DTE coaches, coordinate the distribution of feedback reports to all U18 athletes by Aug 2023.

Both Coach and Assistant Coach will be expected to participate in program debriefing processes and report on the successes and opportunities after each event.

Continuation of these contracts is subject to a positive performance review after concluding the above elements.

Location:

Variable and to be determined based on the location of training and competition.

Qualifications:

All coaches applying to provide their services in these areas must have the following:

- All mandatory SafeSport modules and current criminal records completed
- NCCP Competitive-Development Multisport Trained or show recent progress and commitment toward achieving trained status.
- Must have a current passport and be able to travel internationally.
