Title	Field Hockey Canada (FHC) Masters Committee
Mandate	 The Committee is created by the Field Hockey Canada Board of Directors as an adhoc committee in accordance with bylaw 12.3, activated on March 5th, 2019. The Committee's mandate is: Provide oversight of all Masters Field Hockey activities in Canada, including outdoor, indoor, domestic and international. To guide and encourage development of a Masters play both domestic and international To identify and encourage Masters coaches and officials to active participation in domestic leagues and international events. The mandate of the committee will be carried out within the overall strategic
	guidelines and objectives of FHC. (NB: In concert with FIH World Masters Hockey, Masters field hockey players are those active players over the age of 35).
Key Duties	 To ensure consistency, alignment and adherence to FHC objectives, including but not limited to: events & competitions, talent identification and selection, athlete, coaching and umpiring pathways. Recommend guidelines, policies and support to Provincial Sports Organization (PSO) partners in the implementation of nationally aligned Masters programming and competition. Support PSO's where necessary in the delivery of Masters opportunities. Support and liaise with FHC to send teams to international competitions

Structure and Membership

Appointed by the Field Hockey Canada Board of Directors in accordance with bylaw

12.4, the structure and membership of the Committee shall be the following:

- Executive
 - o Chair: FHC Board Representative as appointed by the FHC BOD
 - o Chairs of each of the 4 sub committees
 - o FHC staff as appointed
- Indoor International Sub Committee
 - Chair: member of the FHC indoor Ad hoc Committee and as approved by the board
 - \circ 3 8 members
 - Geo and gender equity to be applied
- Outdoor international Sub Committee
 - o Chair: recommended by the Executive and approved by the FHC board
 - \circ 3 8 members
 - Geo and gender equity to be applied
- Officials Subcommittee
 - Chair: recommend by the ad hoc FHC Officials Committee and approved by the FHC board
 - Chair: becomes, if not already, a member of the FHC Officials Ad Hoc Committee
 - \circ 3 8 members
 - Geo and gender equity to be applied
- Domestic Play Sub Committee
 - o Chair: recommended by the Executive and approved by the FHC board
 - \circ 3 8 members
 - Geo and gender equity to be applied

Field Hockey Canada may add members to the Committee, or replace members of the Committee, and may seek the advice of the Committee in doing so.

Meetings and Reporting

The Advisory Committee may meet in person, telephonically, or electronically, and otherwise regulate their meetings and proceedings as they see fit (by-law 12.7).

The Committee will report to the Board as and when required by and through the Chair or, if the Chair is not a director of Field Hockey Canada, any other member of the Committee who is a director of Field Hockey Canada.



The Committee shall prepare and submit an annual report to the CEO not less than
six weeks prior to the AGM.
