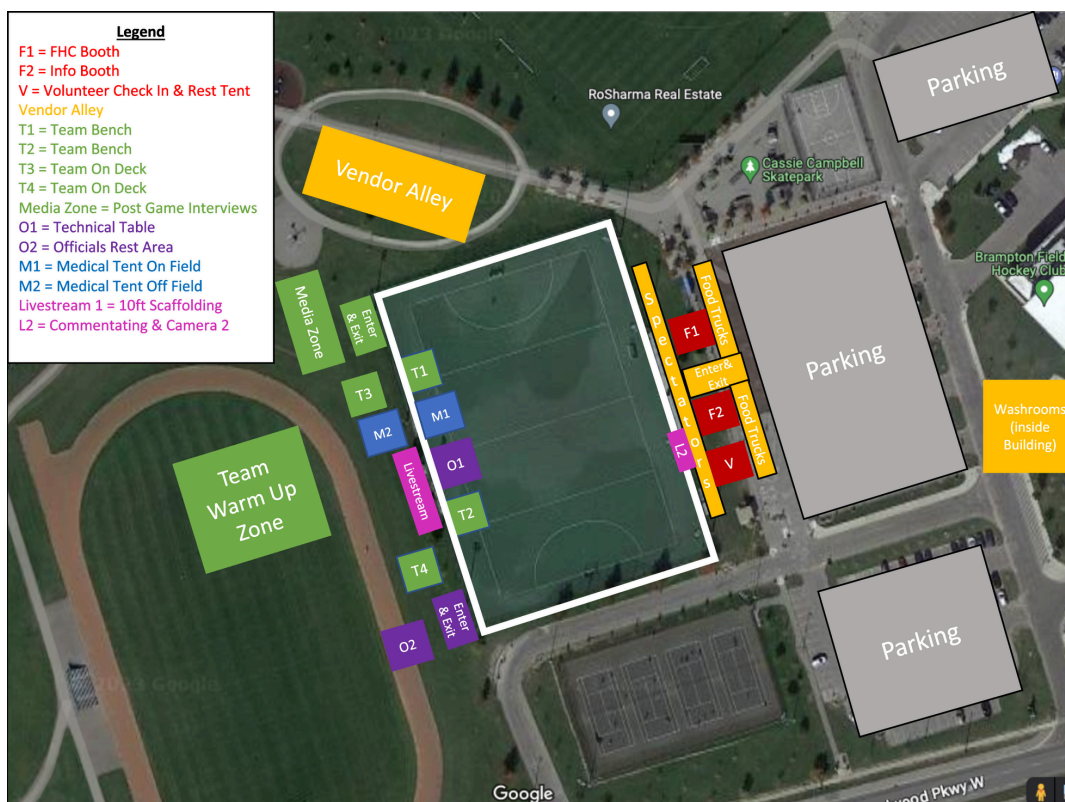

Please be advised, there will be no parking available directly parallel to the field as food trucks for the event will be using this space. The Map on the left indicates this blocked zone.

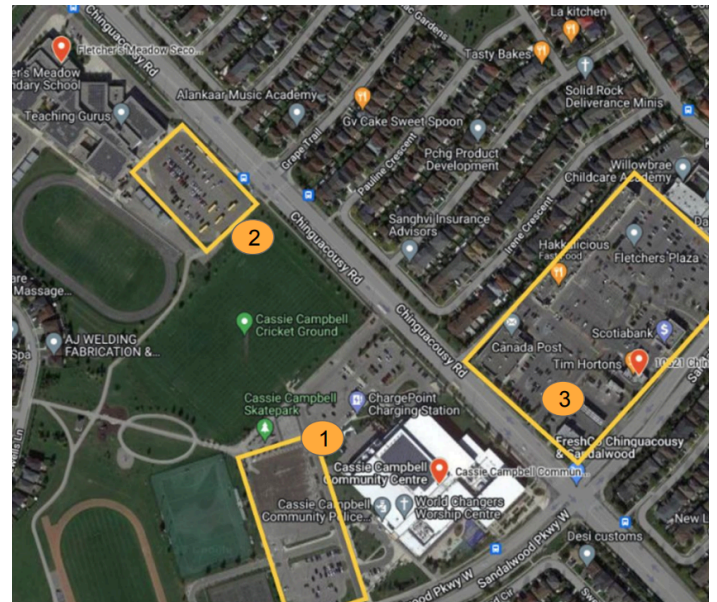
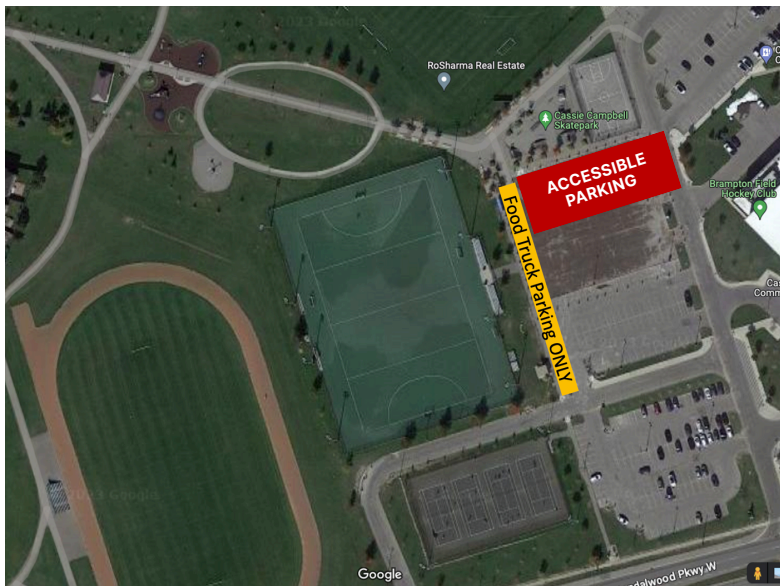
ACCESSIBLE PARKING

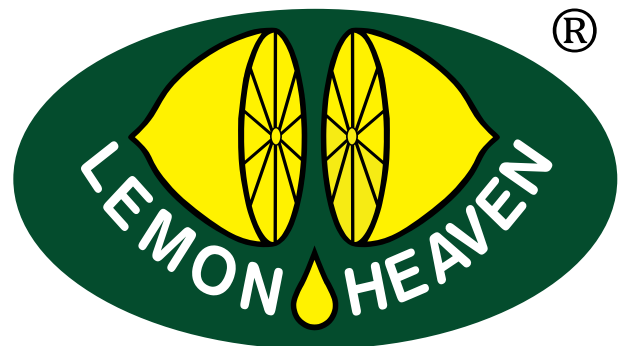
